

## Prior Service Enlistment Bonus Requirements

- Is enlisting in the Air Force Reserve for a term of 3 or 6 years.
- Is enlisting in a bonus Duty Air Force Specialty Code (DAFSC) in effect on the date of enlistment.
- Has not previously been granted an incentive in any Reserve component and the specialty associated with the position the member is enlisting, is a specialty in which member served while on active duty, and is fully qualified.
- Is not enlisting under the PALACE CHASE Program.
- Received an honorable discharge from previous military service.
- Is not enlisting to qualify for a civilian position where membership in the Reserve is a condition of employment.
- Has completed any active service commitment and possesses less than 14 years total service (based on Armed Forces enlistment contractual agreement on pay date) at the time of enlistment.
- Is not enlisting for voluntary assignment to full-time active duty for training in excess of 90 days in support of the Reserve program (does not include individuals attending formal schools over 90 days in length).
- Is not being released from active duty for enlistment in a Reserve component, which does not include transfer to Ready Reserve, according to a member's Military Service Obligation (MSO).
