"Apparently our exercise is going extremely well," said Lt. Col. Larry Turner.

Exercise

"The frag was 48 sorties. We ended up canceling four of them due to Condition Black," the colonel added. "This shouldn't hurt us as we only lost one 'counter'."

The war intensified Friday with increased air and ground attacks throughout NATO's Southern Region. Chemical attacks occurred at several bases, including Cigli AB.

With one more day left, the colonel asked that people continue with their vigilance. "You're all doing a great job. Just stick with us."

Stressing careful observance to unusual occurrences, Colonel Turner asked that unit people keep showing that important sense of urgency. "And, most of all, be safe."

"We've only had a few heat-related incidents and those were minor," he said. "That's better than any other unit to date."

As a result of an air strike, the 507th operated in Condition Black for approximately five hours. This gave the disaster preparedness decontamination team the time required for decontamination of the area, including vehicles and aircraft. Chemicals used against the 507th were blister gas and nerve agents.

Capt. Scotty Wilson, chief of maintenance, feels that without his people, the 507th is just another flying club.

The ground attacks were conducted by Soviet "Speznats" teams. These teams are similar to U.S. Army Special Forces (Green Berets).

"Without my weapons folks, we would just be another airline. The weapons loaders just did terrific. These men and women of mine are Sierra Hotel!"

The Speznats are capable of small boat, parachute or helicopter infiltration. They conduct rapid and destructive attacks on high value NATO targets, such as airfields, radar sites and command/control facilities.

Lt. Col. Dick Eustace, director of operations, added that the whole unit is doing an outstanding job.

"You've all put out a magnificent effort under very trying circumstances," Colonel Turner said. "And, that just proves something about us OKies."

The war is expected to intensify today.

And from out of the shadows was heard,
"OKies is tough!"

The following lists are approximate conversion charts at the current rate of exchange.

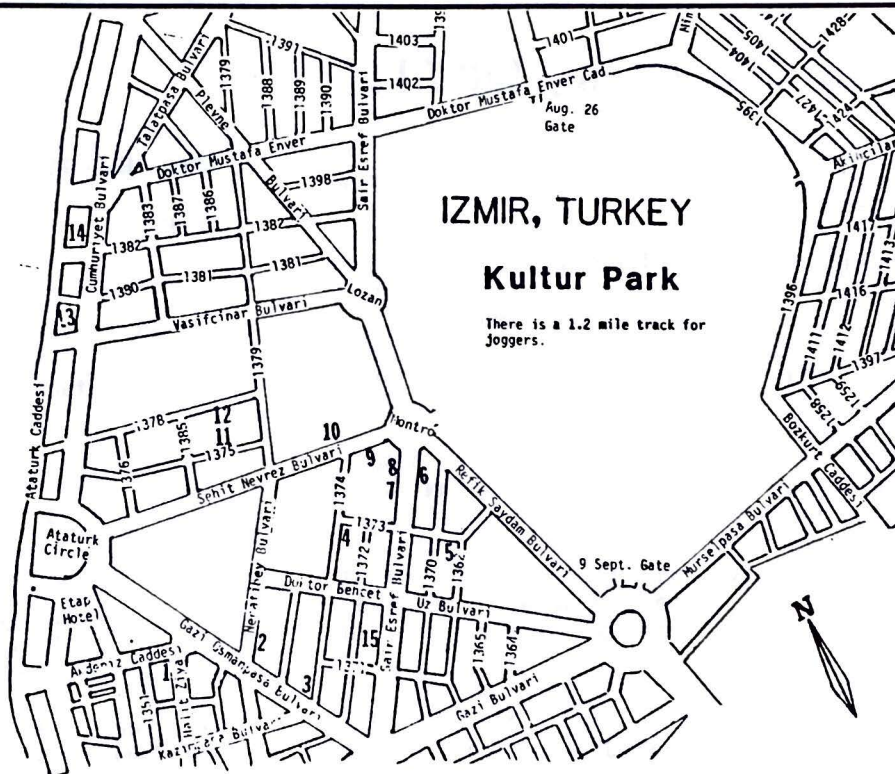
Remember to only change money where the "Authorized Money Exchange" signs are displayed.
